Daley Thompson is considered to be the greatest decathlete of all time. A four times world record holder, Daley won two Olympic gold medals, three Commonwealth titles, two European Championship titles, and a gold medal in World Championship. He also holds the record for being the first athlete to hold the European, Commonwealth, World and Olympics title in a single event simultaneously. Daley remained an undefeated champion of decathlon for nine years straight, from 1978 to 1987.
