He's hosted quizzes for celebrities, as well as corporate clients (like Sky TV, Lacoste, Virgin, Aston Martin F1, NHS, Visit Florida, P&O Cruises). For that extra cherry on top experience, Gavin can even brand the quiz experience, creating bespoke questions or audio and video content to suit.

The quiz uses a cutting edge innovative system where quizzers can use their iPads or phones to answer questions - ensuring a night of competitiveness, creativity and fun!



HOW IT WORKS...

SPEED QUIZZING

- An app is downloaded on a Smart Phone/Tablet (iPhone/iPad). This can be done in advance or at the venue if it was good Wi-Fi or data.
- The venue does NOT need good Wi-Fi for the quiz. We create a local wireless network in the room called 'Quiz' that people log on to. They would only require 'the internet' to get the app.
- One device per team. We recommend a maximum of 6 at team for optimum game play – but we do regularly run events with up to 8.
- You then type in a team name, choose a buzzer song from over 600, and can even take a team selfie.
- Set up is no longer than 5 minutes and very simple with full instructions given.
- After running 800+ of these, we have never had any technical problems that have resulted in the system failing. It's very robust and if in the rare event of a problem there are very quick and trusted ways to get the quiz up and running again within moments.

Speed Quizzing Pros

- VERY clever in the technical process it displays – people always impressed
- It's virtually impossible to cheat
- Instant gratification after each question, which brings teams together cheering
- Can be very tense and get quite (friendly!) competitive with other teams
- No need for markers as all worked out by the system – very easy to run
- No masses of paper to print which is good for any environmental angle



Duration / Format

The quiz is usually played in one of two formats:

- One Act: 60-75 minutes. This is straight through with 5-6 rounds. This is more ideal for if the quiz is part of a programme of activities for your event (i.e. pre-meal, team building activity as part of an Away Day).
- Two Act: 2hr – 2hr 30. 4 Rounds per half at approx. 50 minutes a half with an interval of 20/30 minutes. This is more ideal for if your event is centred around the quiz (i.e. the quiz is the full event).

We always advise against doing rounds between courses in meals.

Playability

- Although this is an app, the entertainment and playability is all on the host. The device is purely just a way to enter answers and manage the event. Please do not think this is technology taking the place of live entertainment!
- Although there are quite a few similar software systems out there, Gav Quiz has used them all and finds Speed Quizzing the most superior system by far in reliability, game play, future development and player enjoyment.
- In Keypad rounds (the most common ones), a question is read out and you have 10 seconds to answer. You press the first letter of the answer (What is the capital of England? L). If it's a name, it's first name (Who was the first man on the moon? N).
- The answer is given straight away. You get points for being correct and speed bonus points if you were 1st fastest, 2nd fastest, 3rd fastest etc.
- The fastest team's name appears on the screen, device – along with their selfie, and their buzzer song plays. This gives instant gratification and a big cheer!
- It is virtually impossible to cheat in the quiz as you have 10 seconds to answer – not long enough to Google.
- Within this keypad format you can also play music/sounds, use pictures and reveal them slowly. You can also enter numbers such as years, have multiple choice questions, and sequence question (but these films in order of release etc.)
- Other types of rounds include Buzzer Rounds (like a gameshow), an advanced Buzzer Round (where people score points for agreeing or disagreeing), Observation Round, Sound Clips (a jukebox where you hit the buzzer when the required song is playing, Nearest To (number, nearest to) and even bingo.
- Other mechanics include Evil Round (lose points for being wrong), Fast Track (Fastrack Some Teams to No.1), A Gameshow wheel for random points, Go Wide (on guess the year half the points for 1 away), Steal points from other team and more.

Scores

- Scoring is all automatic and appears on the screen and devices when the host reads out at intervals in quiz and at end.
- SFX play as scores are revealed with the winner's buzzer song being played. Additional Costs.
- Speed Quizzing requires a license to run which is £30 + VAT per event.
- Ideally, we like to provide a sheet which has a running order on and instructions (1 Sheet Double Sided). We can provide this or client/venue can print. 1 per team.
- For higher-end events with a large number of participants we recommend hiring tablets with the software pre-installed as it is slicker and more stylish than those types of events would allude to. We have preferred suppliers we can recommend.
- For larger scale events we can offer technical assistance we hire directly from Speed Quizzing. This means they can go around and assist with set up to ensure a quick start and are on hand for the event for added reassurance.
- AV System if not in place at venue (can suggest suppliers)

BESPOKE ROUNDS

- After the c.1000 events, we have done, we know what rounds go down well. We have many hundreds of themed rounds including music and video so if a client says, 'Have you got something on travel / movies / 90s Dance music etc.?' – we have many of these ready to go in our back catalogue.
- If a client would like something very specific though for their company that we would have to create, we can create bespoke quiz rounds or entire quizzes. Examples of this can be provided.
- Charges for this are at £600 +VAT for a production day (or £300 + VAT per half day). These will be quoted on before the work required based on the amount of production time

TECH RIDER

We require the most basic tech set up which most venues have. If not, we do have a preferred supplier we can recommend.

- A professional high-quality PA System fit for purpose for an event of its size.
- 1 Microphone (Wireless or a very long cable) that feeds into PA System.
- Sound from a laptop (we provide the laptop) through a 3.5mm headphone jack that feeds into the PA System. We prefer not to use Bluetooth for this option as it's not as reliable as a cable.
- The ability to adjust the individual levels of both inputs as described above on the PA System.
- The above set up to all be with the host where they will be presenting.
- Relevant leads and power sockets to run the above (including 2 plug sockets for equipment we will bring).
- A screen that is big enough for the participants to see, which will be fed by HDMI Input (Although a screen preferential, it is not essential, but it does mean certain rounds may be limited due to a lack of visuals).
