

Our quiz uses keypads which utilise some of the UK's most advanced technology developed by the team behind 'Who Wants to Be a Millionare'.

The normal format is 3 qualifying rounds of multiple choice questions (4 answer options per question). The scoring system is fully computerised with 10 seconds to answer each question - In the event of a tie the computer calculates each teams average answer response time, with the quickest winning through to the next stage. The winner of each round - Team or Individual - then qualifies for the final 'Showdown Final' to battle for the title of Champion Quizzer.

The 'Showdown Final' is a 5 minute podium round with one buzzer for each Individual/Team. At the end of the round the Individual/Team with the most points will be crowned champion(s) gaining maximum points.

Darts with Bobby George & Colin Lloyd

Each team will take on darting legends Bobby George or Colin Lloyd in a game of 301. Team members will take turns taking their throw, with the team completing 301 in the fastest time taking maximum points. Bonus points are available for highest score and highest checkout.





Bobby George is without doubt the most colourful, charismatic and entertaining player in the history of darts. Over the years, Bobby has represented England on 26 occasions and remains in the list of all-time Top 10 winning players for England.



Colin Lloyd, nicknamed Jaws, is an English professional darts player on the Professional Darts Corporation circuit. He is a former world number one ranked player and he has won two major television titles in the PDC – the 2004 World Grand Prix and the 2005 World Matchplay.

Bar Football

Teams will compete in a round robin format with points being awarded in reflection of their final league standings.



Table Skittles

Shove Ha'penny

Shove Ha'penny is a traditional old English pub game where the object is to slide each ha'penny up the board and get it to stop between two lines without touching either, in which case it scores. Players gain points for all of the 'Ha'penny beds' they score in.



Bagatelle

The aim of Bagatelle is to score as many points as possible from launching 3 balls and landing them in the scoring zones. The team with the cumulative highest score will gain maximum points.



Pin Ball Machine

Each team member will try to gain as big a score as possible on a state of the art pin ball machine.
